HISTORY

The Ford F100 Club of SA was formed in October 1981 at Pooraka, a suburb of Adelaide and became incorporated in 1987. In 1995 the Club changed its name to the Ford F100 Club of Australia Incorporated to reflect the fact it is the central national Club for owners of F-Series trucks

MEMBERSHIP

Membership is open to all owners of Freighters, Broncos, F-Series utilities or station wagons however, other Ford trucks built or assembled by Ford in U.S.A., Canada or Australia will be considered.

The backgrounds of Club members varies greatly with age, occupations, and interests, but members share an enthusiasm for their "F" trucks and the Club. There are Club members in all states of Australia with approximately 120 trucks registered.

CLUB ACTIVITIES

The club was formed to promote the restoration, technical knowledge, recreational use and enjoyment of the vehicles and this is reflected in the many varied activities which the club conducts. These include Truck Shows, day and weekend outings and many social events, and the exchange of news and information through the Club Newsletter which is published every two months. Activities are organised by the Committee in SA (for local and national events) and delegates in the various states organise activities for members in their area.
